Chapter 2B

The 1st and 2nd Resurrections



In the biblical scripture there are two very specific occurrences that take place referred to as the 1st and 2nd resurrections, these go hand in hand with the 1st and 2nd deaths as well. The 1st death began in Genesis with Adams fall into sin taking successive generations into spiritual death and separation from God (*“the wages of sin is death” spiritually Rom 6:23*). God had warned Adam that “if you eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you shall surely die”. Adam was never meant to die physically or spiritually yet through sin both these things took place, surely death had come to mankind as God had said. The sins of the fathers are passed on to the sons Ex 34:7, Num 14:18, Det 5:9, until dealt with through the cross and Christ Jn 6:47-58.

Gen 2:16 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die." (NKJV)

When Jesus came then went through the cross where sin and death were defeated spiritually, access to eternal life and forgiveness of sin was then given to mankind through Christ. Up until this point in time man had only known death through sin and his fall from God, he had not known eternal life in heaven with God. When Jesus rose from the dead in great victory over Satan, death and hell the first resurrection had begun for mankind, defeating the 1st deaths bondage over man. In scripture after the cross it now says “ **all who call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved**” Rom 10:8-13, then “**O death where is your sting ?, O grave where is your victory ?**” 1 Cor 15:55-57.

The saints of old new about the resurrection of the dead to come through the Messiah to come, the Sadducees and Pharisees approached Jesus Himself about this issue. The Sadducees did not believe in a resurrection of the dead yet asked Jesus about marriages to do with the dead a hypocritical question, as they did not believe in the dead being raised in resurrection power in the last days, yet the Pharisees did.

Sadducees Ask About the Resurrection

Mat 22:23 - 33 The same day the Sadducees, who say there is no resurrection, came to Him and asked Him, saying: "Teacher, Moses said that if a man dies, having no children, his brother shall marry his wife and raise up offspring for his brother. Now there were with us seven brothers. The first died after he had married, and having no offspring, left his wife to his brother. Likewise the second also, and the third, even to the seventh. Last of all the woman died also. Therefore, in the resurrection, whose wife of the seven will she be? For they all had her."

Jesus answered and said to them, "You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God. For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels

of God in heaven. But concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God, saying, 'I AM THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND THE GOD OF JACOB' ? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living." And when the multitudes heard this, they were astonished at His teaching. (NKJV)

The 1st Resurrection

The first resurrection of the dead started with Jesus resurrection 3 days after the cross affecting the generations of old, as the saints of God of the Old Testament were resurrected, this resurrection power was loosed into the New Testament. The generation of saints going back to Genesis had died or fallen asleep going into Abrahams bosom a term found only once in the Bible (*Lk 16:19-31*), asleep at death is a term Jesus and the Bible uses. This asleep/death state occurred up until Jesus' time, then going into the future things changed the saints after Christ now entered into heaven at death, into the New Jerusalem (*Galatians 4:26; Hebrews 11:10; 12:22-24; and 13:14, Rev 21*) and do so up until His second coming.

The First Resurrection

As said the first resurrection that began 3 days after Jesus was crucified, when Jesus rose from the dead in resurrection power many saints of old Jerusalem were also raised from Abraham's bosom. These dead saints now alive in Christ were seen walking in the streets and talking with people appearing to many. This was the ending of the first death spiritually through Christ alone and the beginning of the first resurrection, this resurrection of the dead was then to be completed at Jesus second coming. The saints seen in the streets of Jerusalem would have been those like Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Ester, Isaiah, Ezekiel, Malachi, David, Joshua, Sampson, Noah, Adam, Abel Old Testament prophets the saints of old. This was all those God considered righteous from generation the generation from the beginning, whom were asleep in Abrahams Bosom a paradise a place spiritually beneath the earth, prior to Christs death and resurrection.

Mat 27:50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit. Then, behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth quaked, and the rocks were split, and the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; and coming out of the graves after His resurrection, they went into the holy city and appeared to many. (NKJV)

The Rich Man and Lazarus

Luk 16:19 "There was a certain rich man who was clothed in purple and fine linen and fared sumptuously every day. But there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, full of sores, who was laid at his gate, desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table. Moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. So it was that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels to Abraham's bosom. The rich man also died and was buried. And being in torments in Hades, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. "Then he cried and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.' But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things; but now he is comforted and you are tormented.

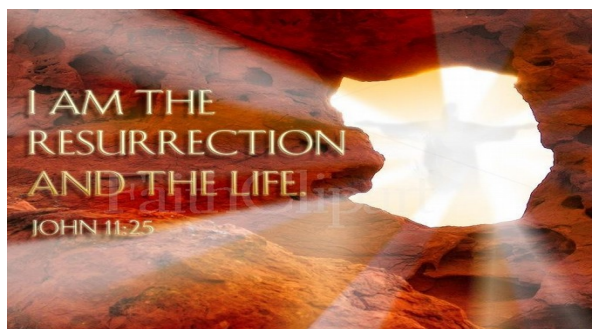
And besides all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed, so that those who want to pass from here to you cannot, nor can those from there pass to us.' "Then he said, 'I beg you therefore, father, that you would send him to my father's house, for I have five brothers, that he may testify to them, lest they also come to this place of torment.' Abraham said to him, 'They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.' And he said, 'No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will repent.' But he said to him, 'If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the dead.' " (NKJV)

While others in Bible history had been **raised from the dead** (the poor widow's son 1 Kings 17:17-23; the man whose corpse revived after it was thrown on top of Elisha's bones 2 Kings 13:21; the son of the widow of Nain Luke 7:11-18; Lazarus John 11:1-46; et cetera), Jesus Christ was the first to be **resurrected**, raised from the dead **never to die again**. Christ was the first man to be **resurrected** in history, never to die again. Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 15:20-23, describing our own resurrection at the "Rapture:" "[20] But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the **first fruits** of them that slept. [21] For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. [22] For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. [23] But every man in his own order: **Christ the first fruits**; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming." In agrarian terminology, the "first fruits" is that small part of the crop that ripens first, before the majority of the crop matures. With regards to resurrection, Jesus Christ is the first Person ever.

We read in Mark 16:19: "So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, **he was received up into heaven**, and sat on the right hand of God." And Luke 24:50-51: "[50] And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them. [51] And it came to pass, while he blessed them, **he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven**." And Acts chapter 1: "[9] And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, **he was taken up**; and a cloud received **him out of their sight**. [10] And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; [11] Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same **Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven**, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen **him go into heaven**."

Jesus Himself spoke to the disciples and the multitudes declaring "**I am the Resurrection and the life**" Jn 11:25. This was where He alone the lamb of God the sinless one the word of God Jn 1:1-15, could be raised from the grave in victory as the resurrection and the life defeating death. This led the way for the 1st resurrection of the dead once Jesus the Messiah had come as prophesied about.



The 1st resurrection continues in prophecy right through until His second coming return, all who are

saved in Christ from the cross forward go into heaven not Abrahams's blossom (*as the saints of old used to*), then He completes the 1st resurrection of the dead at His second coming. Jesus comes with 10 thousand's of His saints Jude 1:14 at His triumphant return to rule and reign with Him on the Earth for 1000 years (*millennial reign of Christ*). The selected saints in heaven return with Christ the dead are raised incorruptible 1 Cor 15:51-56, to rule and reign on the earth during the 1000 years millennial reign. The second death to come (*Great White Throne judgement after 1000 years millennial reign*) will have no power over these saints at all. The alive saints in physical bodies on the earth at His return are also caught up (*1 Thess 4:15-18*) as the 1st resurrection of the dead is completed (*returning with 10 thousand's Jude 1:14*). The alive saints corrupted bodies (*curse of fall 120-year physical life span*) put on incorruptible bodies (*to live 1000 years physically as Adam was meant to*) they are changed in the blink of an eye 1 Cor 15:51-56, protected from His wrath Joel 3:16, then they are translated back onto the earth for the 1000 years. These alive saints with new incorruptible bodies will have marriages and children during this time (*Is 65:17-25*).

Jud 1:14 Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints, to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him." (NKJV)

Rev 20:4-6 And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years. (NKJV)

Rev 5:8-10 Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth." (NKJV)

1Th 4:15-18 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. Therefore comfort one another with these words. (NKJV)

1Co 15:51-56 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality (*uncursed physical bodies clothed in glory that will live 1000 years as Adam was before he fell*), then shall be brought to pass the saying that

is written: "DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP IN VICTORY." "O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING? O HADES, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY?" The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. (NKJV)

New Heavens and a New Earth (restored without curse of fall created for millennial reign)

Isa 65:17-25 "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former shall not be remembered or come to mind. But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create; For behold, I create Jerusalem as a rejoicing, And her people a joy. I will rejoice in Jerusalem, And joy in My people; The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, Nor the voice of crying. "No more shall an infant from there live but a few days (*1000 years reign of Christ for the alive saints at His return who get new incorruptible uncursed from the fall bodies, where marriages will flourish and exist having children born for long life of more than 120 years up to 1000 years as Adam was. No curse of the fall in all creation a new heavens and earth "cleansed from the curse of the fall "a restored creation, even the animals live peacefully with each other*), **Nor an old man who has not fulfilled his days; For the child shall die one hundred years old, But the sinner being one hundred years old shall be accursed** (*this is physical people in the millennial reign of 1000 years with free will a time yet to come after the 7th Trumper wrath of Christ the 3rd woe*).

They shall build houses and inhabit them; They shall plant vineyards and eat their fruit. They shall not build and another inhabit; They shall not plant and another eat; For as the days of a tree, so shall be the days of My people, And My elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands. They shall not labor in vain, Nor bring forth children for trouble; For they shall be the descendants of the blessed of the LORD, And their offspring with them. "It shall come to pass That before they call, I will answer; And while they are still speaking, I will hear. The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, The lion shall eat straw like the ox, And dust shall be the serpent's food. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain," Says the LORD. (NKJV)

The 2nd Resurrection



The 2nd resurrection takes place after the 1000-year millennial reign of Christ on earth with His saints comes to an end. This ends with the last war of Gog (*Satan*) of Magog who is released from the bottomless pit whom gathers his forces from their prisons Is 24:21-23, at the four corners of the earth to come up against God and His saints in the Holy city Jerusalem on earth. Satan as Gog is wiped out by God and all his forces are dealt to with fire coming out of heaven against them they lose completely the saints win.

The Defeat of Satan

Rev 20:7 - 10 Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea. They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them. The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever. (NKJV)

The 2nd resurrection is where all whom ever lived from generation to generation along with fallen angels, are all called up before Gods throne for one final judgement this is all tied into the Great White Throne judgement leading to the 2nd death. This is where even the saints of God will sit on thrones judging the world with Christ, even the fallen angels that are now subject to them will be judged by men. The 2nd death is the casting of all the wicked the angels, Satan, Fallen angels, demons, death and hell into the lake of fire forever. The earth and heaven flee away Rev 21:23, Rev 20:11, the stars are rolled up in the firmament by God Heb 1:10-12. Time is vanquished eternity rules everywhere on earth and in heaven with no division at all, no separation all becomes one lit up by the Father's glory. This casting of the wicked is the 2nd resurrection of all created the wicked go to the resurrection of condemnation the 2nd death (*lake of fire the 2nd death*) and saints go to the resurrection of life. Death and hell/hades are the last two enemies of God judged and cast into the lake of fire in the 2nd death 2nd resurrection Great White throne final judgement of the wicked.

1Co 6:2-3 Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if the world will be judged by you, are you unworthy to judge the smallest matters? Do you not know that we shall judge angels? How much more, things that pertain to this life? (NKJV)

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Judgment Before the Great White Throne

Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works. Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire. (NKJV)

Joh 5:28 Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation. (NKJV)

The New Heaven and the New Earth

Rev 21:1-27 Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. **Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."** Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."

And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts. He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

The New Jerusalem

Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife." And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, having the glory of God. Her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal. Also she had a great and high wall with twelve gates, and twelve angels at the gates, and names written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west. Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. And he who talked with me had a gold reed to measure the city, its gates, and its wall.

The city is laid out as a square; its length is as great as its breadth. And he measured the city with the reed: twelve thousand furlongs. Its length, breadth, and height are equal. Then he measured its wall: one hundred and forty-four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of an angel. The construction of its wall was of jasper; and the city was pure gold, like clear glass. The foundations of the wall of the city were adorned with all kinds of precious stones: the first foundation was jasper, the second sapphire, the third chalcedony, the fourth emerald, the fifth sardonyx, the sixth sardius, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh jacinth, and the twelfth amethyst. The twelve gates were twelve pearls: each individual gate was of one pearl. And the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass.

But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb is its light. And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth

bring their glory and honor into it. Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there). And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it. But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life. (NKJV)

The River of Life

Rev 22:1 And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him. They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads. There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever.

Jesus Is Coming

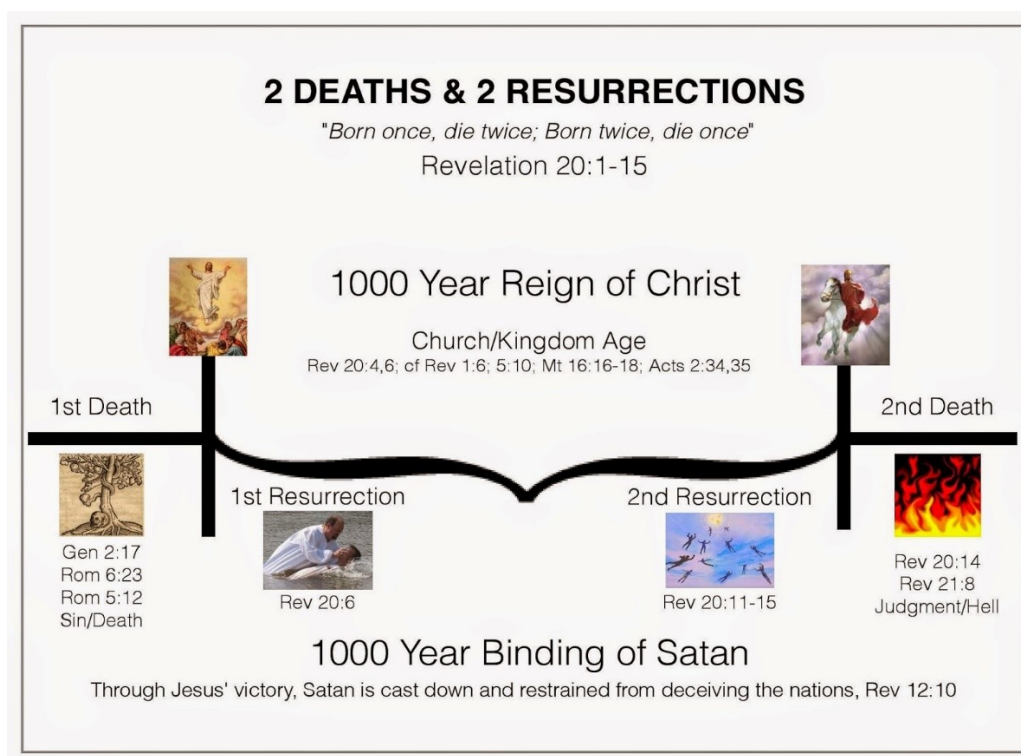
Then he said to me, "These words are faithful and true." And the Lord God of the holy prophets sent His angel to show His servants the things which must shortly take place. "Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book." (NKJV)

At the conclusion of all things being completed Rev 21 and 22, Jesus hands everything He's done back to the Father He gives glory to the Father for all things done. He abolishes all rule authority and power as His kingdom is a Kingdom of love and peace for eternity.

1Co 15:22-24 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. But each one in his own order: Christ the first fruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. (NKJV)

Mark 12:18 Some Sadducees (who say that there is no resurrection) *came to Jesus, and began questioning Him, saying,

Luke 20:27 Now there came to Him some of the Sadducees (who say that there is no resurrection),

Acts 23:8 For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, nor an angel, nor a spirit, but the Pharisees acknowledge them all.

2 Timothy 2:18 men who have gone astray from the truth saying that the resurrection has already taken place, and they upset the faith of some.

He is not the God of the dead but of the living.”

Mark 12:24-27 Jesus said to them, “Is this not the reason you are mistaken, that you do not understand the Scriptures or the power of God? For when they rise from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven. But regarding the fact that the dead rise again, have you not read in the book of Moses, in the passage about the burning bush, how God spoke to him, saying, ‘I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob’? He is not the God of the dead, but of the living; you are greatly mistaken.”

Luke 20:34-38 Jesus said to them, “The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage, but those who are considered worthy to attain to that age and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry nor are given in marriage; for they cannot even die anymore, because they are like angels, and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection. But that the dead are raised, even Moses showed, in the passage about the burning bush, where he calls the Lord the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. Now He is not the God of the dead but of the living; for all live to Him.”

1 Corinthians 15:35-44 But someone will say, “How are the dead raised? And with what kind of body do they come?” You fool! That which you sow does not come to life unless it dies; and that which you sow, you do not sow the body which is to be, but a bare grain, perhaps of wheat

or of something else. But God gives it a body just as He wished, and to each of the seeds a body of its own. All flesh is not the same flesh, but there is one flesh of men, and another flesh of beasts, and another flesh of birds, and another of fish.

There are also heavenly bodies and earthly bodies, but the glory of the heavenly is one, and the glory of the earthly is another. There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for star differs from star in glory. So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown a perishable body, it is raised an imperishable body; it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body.
